Annual Report 2009-10

The members of the V.M.C who stood by us through thick and thin are present here to witness the function and give us moral support. I on behalf of our Vidyalaya family, whole heartedly welcome them to our midst. To the PTA executive committee members who have extended a helping hand to us in each of our endeavours, I give a warm welcome with folded hands. To the parent community I have just one word to relate - you are always welcome for your encouragement and support.

Once again I take this opportunity to welcome this august gathering to our Annual Day celebrations.

For a testimony of ourselves, a brief summary of the activities and accomplishments of our school for the year 2009 – 10 is essential.

Academic Achievements

The academic results of the public examination are the real touch stone to assess the success of any educational enterprise. We presented 84 students in class XII Science stream and 18 students in the commerce stream securing 100% result in the science stream and 96.7% in the commerce stream. It was a momentous occasion when we secured a 100% result in the Xth standard Board Examination in the 1st shift and 97.8% in the II shift, with Mast : Anandapadmanabhan receiving the topper's merit certificate from CBSE in SST and Mast : Roshan Santhosh being awarded the topper's merit certificate in Maths and English. Mast : Roshan Santhosh who stood sixth in the AISSE 2009 was also the proud recipient of the merit certificate from KVS followed by a cash prize of Rs5000/- for scoring 97.6%. It's a matter of pride that KVS has sponsored Mast : Roshan Santhosh for GYNESYS Programme – a joint venture of the Govt. of India and Japan sponsored by the Govt. of Japan. The whole Vidyalaya Community held its head high on receipt of certificate of excellence from KVS for CBSE Examination results. The School's performance index speaks for itself. We had creditable results in the SEE Examinations of both the shifts bagging 97.7 % and 98.8 % in the Ist and IInd shifts respectively.

Social Science Exhibition

The KVS leaves no stone unturned in bringing out the capabilities of each child. Both shifts of the Vidyalaya participated in Cluster level & Regional level Social Science Exhibition.

The Cluster level Social Science Exhibition held at KV Army Cantt. Pangode on 9th Oct 2009 saw our pupils bringing home laurels in the field of Drawing, Solo Song, Light Music, Group song and Sketching.

One of our exhibits made its way to the National Level too .The whole school applauded the achievement of Mast : Sachu and Vipin Chandran of class XII who walked away with the 1 st prize in KVS National Level Quiz Competition in connection with the All India Social Science Exhibition 2009-10 held at Chandigarh.

Science Exhibition

School level Science Exhibition saw almost 80 models exhibited and the best 4 models were sent for the Regional Level Science Exhibition at K.V Ashok Nagar, Chennai.

166 students participated in the Science Olympiad Examination conducted by National Science Olympiad Foundation and a good number of them were proud recipients of the Merit Certificates .

Two of our students Navneeth Krishna and Vignesh B.S got selection for the Second Round of Examination.

Under the theme “Science Technology Students and Society” conducted by J.N Vidyalaya level Science Exhibition, 5 of our students represented the Vidyalaya in the Regional level.

CMP Programmes

The KVS Pilot project Common Minimum Programme aimed at the improvement of Primary education in infrastructure and teaching methods were implemented in true spirit and was successful in implementation.Under this programme many activities such as Vidyalaya level and Cluster level competitions in CCA and sports & games ,regular educational film shows ,field trips for all students activity oriented class room teaching etc were conducted.

Our tiny tots also made us proud by bagging innumerable prizes in the Cluster Level Competition in CCA held under the Common Minimum Programme for the primary children. Children from both shifts participated in these programmes & made a clean sweep of most of the prizes.

Cultural Competitions

The Cultural Competitions held in and around the city saw our pupils walking away home with trophies and cash prizes.

Mast: Advait M of class VI, Aravind T of VIII and Roji Joseph of VII stood first in the quiz competition held by YMCA Parakode.

Similarly Mast: Aravind T and Advait M bagged the third prize in quiz competition for High School Students organized by the NRI Forum Adoor.

Our students proved that there is no dearth of creative talent.

Kumari Shilpa Varghese of class11 bagged the second prize in Essay Writing Competition organized by Bharat Hindi Prachar Kendra.

Kumari Sandhya Sathish stood first in the All Kerala Cluster Debate Competition.

Cyber Olympiad.

Many of our students actively participated in the Cyber Olympiad conducted by the the National Science Olympiad foundation and came out with flying colours.

Maths Olympiad.

K.V. Adoor was selected as the Centre for the K.V.S Regional Mathematics Olympiad and 24 of our pupils appeared for the examination.

The Arts Club of both the shifts had a laurel Spree year with Pupils bagging trophies and prize money left and right.

Our Child Artist Kumari Shivani.R of class 5B was the proud recipient of the Gold Medal in the All India Kendriya Vidyalaya Child Art Exhibition organised by K.V Rajamundry. She had a rich haul of prizes, being the first in District level painting competition organised by the Council of Child Welfare Pathanamthitta, second in District level painting on Financial literacy organised by Reserve Bank of India.

Kumari Aditya.S.Raj, another Child Prodigy won first in the District level painting on Financial Literacy Banking organised by Federal bank of India, First in District level painting in connection with Gandhi Jayanti Week Celebrations organized by public relations dept. govt. of kerala,1st in drawing and painting in connection with flower and fruit show organized by the Agri-Horti society kozhencheri,3rd in wild week celebrations organized by forest wild life dept.govt. of kerala.

Greeshma joy of class IIIrd won the 1st prize in district level painting in connection with children's day celebration organized by council for children welfare pathanamthitta, whereas Sandra joy of class 4 stood 2nd .

Akshai of class IX proved his worth by winning 1st in peace poster contest organized by lions club Kulanada .

Anand raj of VII B stood 1st in the cluster level sketching competition and ran 2nd in the dist.level pencil drawing competition in connection with wild life week organized by forest and wild life dept.govt.of kerala.

James Joseph J of class VII B received merit memento in all India kv child art exhibition 2009 organised by KV Rajamundry.

Greeshma S of II A and Vrinda S of II B were the runners up in the S and M kids wear and Balarama art contest.

Kashmeera of IV A and Sabi Mariam Biji of III A too added laurels to the vidyalaya. Justin Joseph and Hrithik Vidhyadharan had their works selected for school level best entry winners in painting competition.

The foray of our students into the world outside participating in various competitions such as Akhila Kerala Balachithra Rachana, E V Smaraka grandhasala, Varnam 2009, International peace poster competition etc proved the soundness of the education we impart.

Sports and Games

Another leap we made was in the field of sports and games.

The volley ball and basketball teams from both shifts participated in the cluster level competitions and they went on further to take part in the regional level competition with the boys volleyball team bagging the regional level trophy, not just basketball and volley ball, our pupils proved their worth in other fields of sports as Table Tennis, Chess, Taekwondo & brought home 1 Gold, 3 Silver & 2 Bronze Medals.

Master Sajin Samuel, Master Akhil Tulasi, Master Pranav Raveendran, Master Zubin Mathew, Master Rahul Nair, Master Rajesh, all of the Senior Secondary Section were selected for representing the Chennai Region in the K.V.S Nationals. In the field of Athletics, Kumari Gopika Gopinath of Class 11 upheld the flag of K.V. Adoor when she won the Gold Medal in the 4x400 metres relay in K.V.S Nationals. A cash award of 2500 was awarded to her by K.V.S. Names of many more winners in different fields of activities at Local, Cluster and Regional levels needs to be mentioned, but time constraint forces me to put a stop.

School Activities

The ECO Club, UNESCO Club, Library Club, Music Club are an asset to the children. The introduction of a unit of National Green Corps with more than 100 active members provide valuable service in the form of organizing different activities and competitions on important days like World Earth Day, World Environment Day, World Ozone Day etc..

The Co - Curricular activities in the school go on a weekly basis. This helps us to tap the creativity hidden in each child & helps us to guide the child in the right direction.

The Vidyalaya's unit of Scouts and Guides are in a way the backbone of the institution. They rise up to all occasions silently promising us their services.

Music happens to be the food of soul. Our children are well versed in all fields of classical arts, be it on the Tabla, the Guitar, the Veena or the Violin. A glimpse into the gallery of the Musical Evening leaves behind all doubts.

Infrastructure :

To strive, to seek to achieve and never to yield has been our motto. We have extended our boundaries and added up nine classrooms, staff quarters and a well equipped computer lab to our existing infrastructure.

The Multipurpose Audio Visual rooms separate for primary and secondary sections complete with LCD Projectors, Computers with internet connection, Overhead Projectors, 29" Color T V are something we take pride in.

To keep up with fast moving times, we have equipped our two computer labs with the latest computers and Broadband Internet Connection. The Maths lab, Language lab, Art room, Teaching Aids room have been developed to give our children the best of everything.

We take pride in the automated and well equipped Library which houses 8800 books of different streams, 35 Periodicals & 6 different editions of newspapers. Around 80,000 rupees have been spent this year on new arrivals. Learning ought to be an educational affair, the school organizes Educational Trips to various parts of the state.
